Purpose of Speeches

Persuade
Convince your audience to agree with an opinion, belief or to change an action.



Inform
Provide factual information for your audience to learn about a subject.



Entertain
Engage and capture your audience with humour and stories.



► What is a speech?

It is an example of a persuasive text. It involves someone delivering their opinion to an audience, stating reasons and explanations and in turn, persuading an audience.

e.g., prime minister delivering a speech, captains talking at an assembly, the principal talking to the school etc.
