

- Seeds
- Flowers
- Fruits
- Tender roots
- Insects such as caterpillars, beetles and grasshoppers

Habitat


- Australia
- Grassland, dry forest, wooded savannah and semi-desert

Appearance

- Weight 18-60kg
- Height 150-190cm
- Length 148-157cm
- Shaggy brown feathers
- Long, powerful legs
- Three toes

Lifestyle

- Solitary bird but will be social when sharing a nest or food
- Emus migrate together when moving to new food sources
- Diurnal (sleep at night, active during the day)
- Playful with other emus will bite or peck another emu and run away
- Communicate through an inflatable neck sack
- Male emus sit on the eggs and look after the chicks



 Carnivores - mice and small mammals, insects, yabbies, lizards, small birds and snakes


Appearance

- Females lay 3 eggs, both the female and male sit on the nest



- Adult crocodiles mud crabs, snakes, turtles, birds, wild boars, monkeys and buffalos


Appearance



Classification

- Mammal
- Live around 30 years

<u>Habitat</u>

- Forests
- Grasslands
- Scrub
- Dense vegetation
- Underground burrows

Diet

Insects and earthworms

Appearance

- Weight 5-l0kg
- Length 60-100cm
- White spines
- Dense brown/black fur
- Sharp claws

Lifestyle

- Solitary but not territorial
- Hibernate during winter months in their burrow
- Become nocturnal in warmer months to avoid the heat
