Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) is one of the six key learning areas of the NSW primary curriculum. Our school's PDHPE program aims to help our students develop and lead healthy, active and fulfilling lives.

Our school's PDHPE program includes content relating to relationships, drug use, child protection, fundamental movement skill development, safety and physical activity. Some of the content of the program deals with sensitive issues. The school recognises this by teaching about these issues within the context of a developmentally appropriate program and by providing information to you about the program.

The PDHPE program aims to encourage students to make informed decisions about their lifestyle, taking into account the values of the family, culture and religion to which they belong.

This term, Stage 2 will be learning about some aspects of Child Protection. An overview of some of the content of the Child Protection program is provided below.

- Appropriate and inappropriate touching and personal body warning signals.
