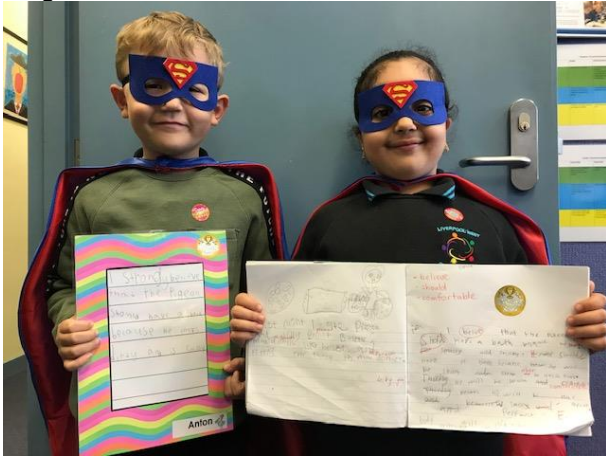

Our Dance Group practicing for the Festival.

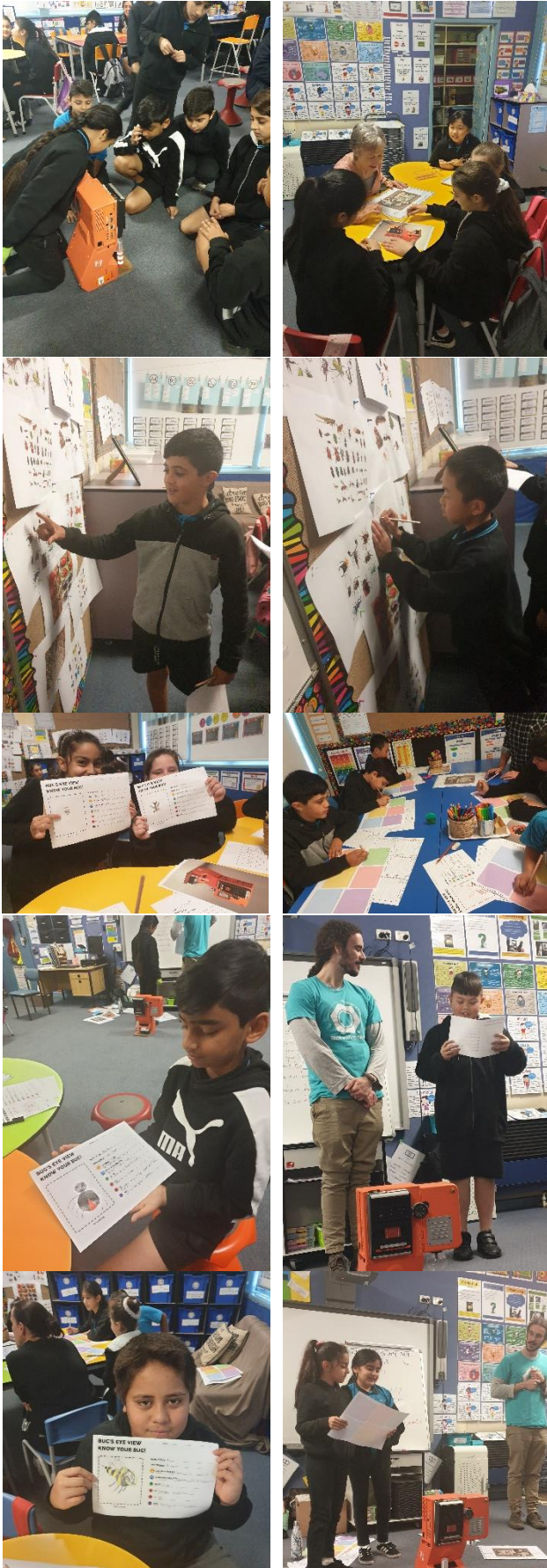
